The International Cultic Studies Association (ICSA) Annual Conference was held in Montreal from July 5-7. The conference was hosted by Info-Cult and organized in collaboration with the Université de Montréal, the International Centre for Comparative Criminology (ICCC) of the Université de Montréal, and l'Association québécoise Plaidoyer-Victimes.

Two hundred and fifty people from 16 countries attended and for about 40% of the attendees this was their first time participating at one of these conferences. Participants included academics, mental health professional, law enforcement personnel, families, media, members and former group members and the general public.

The conference provided a range of sessions for academics, mental health professionals, families and former members and highlighted the fact that there is still much to do especially as it pertains to the need for more specialized services for former members who often face great difficulty in integrating into mainline society after an extreme group experience

Feedback about the conference was extremely positive and people remarked on the quality and scope of the presentations, and the open and respectful manner in which discussions were held.
